Residential Accommodation at The Nurtons

Residential accommodation runs from the evening before the course until the last day of the course. An extra night's accommodation can be arranged at extra cost if you wish to leave the day after the course. The prices for 2012 are as follows:

2 day courses - £70	Single room supplement - £20
3 day courses - £105	Single room supplement - £30

Residential accommodation is limited so please book early to avoid disappointment.

Accommodation is in spacious en suite twin/double and a limited number of single rooms. The residential cost includes continental style breakfast with fresh fruits & juices, home baked breads, selection of mueslis, etc. Lunch and tea/coffee breaks are included in the course fee. For eating in the evenings there are simple self catering facilities available or there are several pubs/hotels in Tintern. Evening meals at The Nurtons for a group may be possible some evenings by arrangement.

Directions by car

Coming from the South-West on the M5

- Take M5 junction 15 onto the M4 westbound, signed for South Wales
- Then follow the directions below

Coming from the East on the M4

- Take M4 junction 21 onto the M48, signed for Chepstow
- Continue on the M48 across the toll bridge (you will need cash - currently £5.40)
- Immediately after the bridge take junction 2, signed for Chepstow
- At the motorway roundabout take the 3rd exit, signed for Chepstow
- Go for 1 mile on dual carriageway
- At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit, signed A466 Wye Valley
- After about 5 miles on the A466 you will come to the village of Tintern
- Go through Tintern then take a left turn up a long driveway signposted "The Nurtons" opposite the entrance to The Old Station.

Total journey time from the motorway at Chepstow is about 15 minutes.

Coming from South Wales on the M4

- Take M4 junction 23 onto the M48, signed for Chepstow
- Take junction 2 signed for Chepstow
- At the motorway roundabout take the 1st exit, signed for Chepstow
- Then follow the directions above from "Go for 1 mile on dual carriageway" onwards

Coming from the Midlands or the North on the M5

- Take M5 junction 8 onto the M50
- Go for 21 miles until the motorway ends
- At the roundabout take A449 signed Ross-on-Wye and Monmouth (A40)
- The A449 soon turns into the A40, keep going on this for 12 miles until you reach Monmouth
- You need to take a left turn across a bridge, just after some traffic lights, signed A466
- Follow the A466 for 10 miles until you come to the village of Tintern
- Just before you enter Tintern take a right turn up a long driveway signposted "The Nurtons" opposite the entrance to The Old Station. There are also signs to "The Nurtons" as you approach the turning.

Parking

The Nurtons has ample off-road parking.

Coming by coach

The nearest coach stop is Chepstow. In many cases getting to Chepstow by coach is easier and cheaper than by train. There are direct National Express coaches from many places in UK, including London Victoria and Heathrow Airport.

Coming by train

The nearest train station is Chepstow.

Let us know when your train arrives and we will see how we can help.

Coming by air

Cardiff is the nearest international airport. A free shuttle bus takes you to Rhoose Cardiff International Station. Trains run every hour from here to Cardiff Central Station where you can get a direct train to Chepstow.

Alternatively you may find it easier and cheaper to fly to London Heathrow airport from where you can get a direct coach to Chepstow.
